A Monart glass bowl, 1930s, shape BI, of flared circular form on a small foot, in colourway '434' with a whorl pattern in blue and pink, diameter 29cm, applied paper label to base.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

Three internal cracks to base interior of bowl, one 4cm and two 3cm long, the longest with tiny chip to surface, otherwise all internal. Small fracture to edge of foot - only really noticeable on close inspection. The applied paper label is torn and dog-eared, it has probably been re-glued at some stage.
