A Worcester teapot and cover, circa 1775, painted with gilt enriched Imari floral decoration to the globular body, the cover with pointed finial, blue painted open crescent mark to base, height 12.5cm (some restoration to rim), together with a Worcester teapot and cover, painted with Chinese style figures, height 14.5cm (restored).

Condition Report

Floral teapot - handle professionally restored back into position through both terminals. Area of restoration to approx one quarter section of top rim where cover sits, similar area of restoration to edge of cover. Knop of cover with professional restoration to tip. Overall typical light surface wear/scratches.

Figural teapot - rivet repairs to handle in three places, haircrack to diameter of cover.
