A Worcester reeded French shape teacup and saucer, circa 1780, painted with floral swags divided by gilt scrolls around a central green caillouté gilt edged circular panel, the cobalt blue rim with gilt overlaid decoration, underglaze blue 'W' mark to bases, diameter of saucer 13.5cm, together with a similarly decorated Sèvres influenced teabowl and saucer. First teacup and saucer - minor chip to footrim of cup, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Gilding and enamels good.

Second teabowl and saucer - minute nick to footrim of teabowl, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, the saucer has some wear.
