A Worcester teabowl and saucer, circa 1765-75, painted in underglaze blue with The Waiting Chinaman pattern, clobbered in iron red and green enamels with gilt highlights, blue painted 'W' marks, diameter of saucer 12.4cm, together with a small group of mostly Worcester wares, including a Mansfield coffee can, height 6cm, a Three Flowers coffee can and a Royal Lily coffee can, height 62cm (faults). Waiting Chinaman teabowl and saucer - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, decoration good.

Mansfield coffee can - haircrack to handle.

Three Flowers coffee can - in good condition overall.

Royal Lily coffee can - in good condition overall.

Gilliflower saucer - 3 small chips and haircrack to rim.

Teabowl - chip to rim, blurry decoration.

Small bowl - vertical crack.
