A Caughley circular butter tub, cover and stand, circa 1775-80, printed in blue with the Three Flowers pattern beneath cell borders, the cover with floral knob, hatched blue 'C' marks to bases, diameter of stand 16.5cm, together with a small group of similar Worcester, including an oval Three Flowers butter tub with matched Fence pattern cover, a Fence pattern circular stand, a Bandstand sugar bowl, height 7.5cm, two Mansfield teapots and a Fence teapot and cover (faults and losses). Provenance: the property of Michael Godfrey.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Caughley butter tub, cover and stand - restoration to floral knob of cover, otherwise each piece in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Oval butter tub with matched cover - tub has branched crack which has stabilized restoration, tiny nicks to relief flowers of handle terminals. Cover has minor spot of restoration to rim and is missing one applied flower. Fence pattern stand - in good condition overall.

Two Mansfield teapots - both missing covers, one has a small chip to the spout, otherwise both with surface wear/scratches.

Fence teapot - cover is matched as it is a little too small, large crack to body and chip to rim, small chips to knob of cover which has repair to flange.

Bowl - minor chip to footrim, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
