A pair of apple green glass decanters and stoppers, possibly Richardson, circa 1840, the faceted bodies with ringed collars beneath mushroom stoppers, star-cut bases, height 29.5cm. Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

I would suggest the decanters are hand blown.

They are both in good condition with some typical light and minor surface scratches and some minor nicks/digs to the facet edges/rims, which are only noticeable on close inspection.

One of the stoppers has a clean glued repair to the base end, only noticeable on very close inspection and by the fact this stopper sits slightly lower when in situ. Otherwise both stoppers are a good fit.
