An Art Deco Shelley Vogue shape Green Block pattern part service, circa 1930, designed by Eric Slater, comprising two large plates, teapot and cover, hot water pot with plated tappit lid, twelve teacups and saucers, twelve tea plates, milk jug and sugar bowl (minor faults).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

One cup with stained vertical haircrack by handle.

One saucer with small chip and two stained flaws to rim edge. Two other saucers have minor stain spots to the rim edge, and of these one also has a fine haircrack to the well.

One tea plate heavily crazed with staining and small chip to rim edge. One tea plate very finely heavily crazed with very minor staining. One tea plate with small haircrack to one corner.

Otherwise the service is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is very typical minor surface wear/scratches commensurate with age and use but nothing untoward or unsightly.
