A Coalport ornithological cabinet plate, mid-19th century, painted in the style of John Randall with a bird perched on a tulip, surrounded by flowers and two insects within a moulded gilt edged rim, red painted inscription 'Le Cubla' to reverse, diameter 23.3cm, together with a pair of similarly moulded floral painted Coalport rectangular dishes.

Condition Report

Each piece in good condition overall with no cracks or chips. There is typical light wear/scratches to the painting overall.

The circular plate has rubbing to the gilt rim with some very minor re-touching.

The gilt rims of both square plates have been entirely re-gilt.
