## Condition Report

Meeting vase - 26cm tall. In good condition overall with no damage or repairs, slight rough patch to longest side edge at top of vase, almost as though it hasn't been polished properly, therefore would seem to be a manufacturing issue.

Sculptural form - 32cm tall. In good condition with no damage or repairs.

Vase - 20cm tall. Pinhead sized dig to widest part of body.
