A Chinese Canton famille rose porcelain vase, mid to late 19th century, of shouldered baluster form, painted with opposing figural panels, reserved against a ground filled with fruit, flowers and two magpies, the shoulder applied with four chilong beneath a pair of Buddhistic lion handles, height 34.5cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1130. Generally good clean condition. Small chip and hairline to tail of one Buddhistic lion handle, the other lion handle with hairline to tail, minor chip to front left leg of one blue chilong on neck and other blue chilong with hairline across its neck. Otherwise, no other significant damage or repairs. Typical minor wear to gilt and enamels.
