1083. Generally good condition.

The enamel panels are in generally good order, some with hairlines which can be seen in the images on our website, but no significant chips, losses or repairs. Colours are good and vibrant. Turquoise enamel backs in generally good order with some typical hairlines. Metal mounts also in good order.
