A Chinese famille rose porcelain teapot and cover, mark of Daoguang but later, the circular body painted with figures of a lady and gentleman divided by lines of black text and iron red seals, iron red enamelled seal mark to base, height 12cm (chip to spout), together with a Japanese Satsuma earthenware globular pot, Meiji period, painted with opposing figural panels, gilt signature to base, height 4.4cm.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1012. Teapot and cover - chip to tip of spout and hairline to underside of spout, otherwise in good condition with typical light surface scratches to glaze, gilt and enamels.

Satsuma pot - generally good condition, typical light crazing to glaze, typical minor wear to enamels and gilt.
