A pair of Chinese famille rose enameled porcelain figures of maidens by Wei Hong Tai, late Qing dynasty/early Republic period, each modelled standing wearing colourful dress, applied moulded signature plaque to each interior underside, height 27.8cm (some restoration and minor faults).

1045. Both figures in generally good condition except for restoration to both hands of each figure. The restoration also includes the necrusted flowers. One of the heads has been broken off and re-glued. Typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels.
