A Chinese famille verte porcelain ginger jar and cover, late 19th century, painted with opposing panels of pheasant, rocks and peony, height 13cm (cover repaired), together with a pair of Chinese Canton famille rose porcelain vases, mid to late 19th century, enamelled with Buddhistic lions, bat, cash and vapours, height 24cm (faults).

Condition Report

1136. Famille verte jar - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear. The cover has been broken in half and rivet repaired.

Famille rose vase 1 - neck has been broken and repaired. Two sections of the rim have been broken out and reglued. Section of rim broken out (approx 3.5cm x 1cm). Typical glaze crazing and typical wear to enamels.

Famille rose vase 2 - neck has been broken and repaired. Section of rim broken out in three pieces and reglued (6.5cm x 2cm). Typical glaze crazing and typical wear to enamels.
