A Japanese Koransha Fukagawa Imari porcelain bowl, Meiji period, of lobed circular form, painted with segmented panels of ho-o birds, dragons and flowers, underglaze blue mark to base, diameter 28.5cm, together with a similarly decorated Imari porcelain circular charger, diameter 46cm (both cracked).

Condition Report

1036. Bowl - has an 8cm vertical hairline crack to rim. Typical wear to gilt and glaze, more pronounced to rim and interior.

Dish - two hairlines (9cm and 6cm long) to rim, otherwise typical surface scratches and wear to gilt and enamels.
