### LOT 1203

A Japanese Satsuma earthenware coffee set, Meiji period, comprising coffee pot and cover, milk jug and cover, sugar bowl and cover (handle damaged), ten cups and ten saucers, each painted and gilt with figural scenes within simulated brocade borders, gilt and black signature and gilt and red Shimazu mon to bases, height of coffee pot 17cm (some faults).

Estimate: £150 - £200

### Condition Report

1203. All pieces with typical light crazing and minor discolouration/staining to glaze visible to interiors. Typical light wear to gilt and enamels, but generally decoration is fresh and vibrant. All with good clear signatures to base.

Teapot and cover - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Sugar bowl and cover - one handle broken into three pieces and detached, otherwise in good condition.

Milk jug and cover - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

8 cups - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

1 cup - missing handle

1 cup - chip to rim.

10 saucers - generally good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. All with more pronounced staining to glaze on undersides.
