A William and Mary walnut and marquetry inlaid chest of two short and three long drawers, raised on turned bun feet, height 93cm, width 100cm, depth 60cm (later handles and other minor alterations).

Provenance: from the principal contents of Stone House, Bolney, West Sussex.

Condition Report

2011. The top has some repaired cracks missing through the veneers and some small areas of replacement banding, but generally the majority is original. Both sides are in reasonably good order, but there are some replacement mouldings to the underside edge of the top and around the low frieze. The drawers have replacement handles and escutcheons, as well as additional filled-in holes either side of current handle placement. Bottom drawer is lacking a lock and the feet appear to be later too. Left front corner of moulding is lacking a small chunk and there are the typical marks, scuffs and knocks commensurate with its age.
