A small group of Siamese silver jewellery, comprising two bracelets, two brooches, two pairs of earrings and an odd earring, each decorated with deity motifs, a ring with bead and wirework decoration, a pair of matching earrings and a similar brooch, total weight 173.1g, together with a small group of other jewellery, including a faience scarab beetle mounted bracelet, a Mikimoto single row necklace of graduated cultured pearls, with a case, another cultured pearl necklace and a single row necklace of rhodonite beads.

Mikimoto pearl necklace - the clasp is detailed 'WG' and 'K9' between the typical Mikimoto mark (M within the outline of an oyster shell). The pearls are generally a little dirty, with some signs of wear, one or two with natural flaws to the nacre. Largest pearl is 7.3mm in diameter, smallest pearl is 3.5mm in diameter.

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
