### LOT 651

A Norwegian David Andersen sterling silver and rhodochrosite pendant in a drop shaped pierced oval design, detailed 'D-A 925S Norway-Sterling INV.B.S.O', weight 21.9g, length 5.1cm, with a Trollsmykke leather pouch.

Estimate: £70 - £100

### Condition Report

The pendant was designed by Bjorn Sigurd Ostern, for David Andersen. The design is called 'Ship of Good Fortune', from the Troll Series launched circa 1964.

The central rhodochrosite has some typical colour variation and is often constructed with various jagged layers - we think with the absence of any obvious signs of an impact to damage the stone, that the horizontal line running across it, (evident in the image) has naturally occurred within the stone, possibly having filled with dirt making it more obvious to a viewer over time. There is certainly no signs of the stone working loose from its setting.

Otherwise the pendant is generally in good condition, with minimal surface wear/scratching, with crisp hallmarks to the reverse.

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
