A 9ct gold and garnet five stone ring, Birmingham 1978, ring size approx P1/2, a gold and half-pearl horseshoe shaped ring, detailed '9ct', and a gold and imitation turquoise single stone ring, Chester 1937, total weight 8.1g, with three cases.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Garnet ring - central garnet with one or two tiny nicks to facet edges, there is a slight split to one shoulder, not detrimental to the ring.

Horseshoe ring - pearls with attractive lustre, minimal wear to shank.

Imitation turquoise - number of chips to the edges of the stone, wear to the table and edges of stone overall.

Resized badly in the past, staining to shank.

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
