A silver cased keyless wind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the enamelled dial showing visible escapement, with Roman numerals on green enamelled roundels, import mark London 1919, case diameter 4.7cm, with carved treen case, together with two keywind open-faced fob watches, each detailed '0,935', a silver cased keywind open-faced fob watch, Birmingham 1884, with a case, and an Omega silver cased keyless wind open-faced fob watch with unsigned jewelled lever movement, the Omega case detailed '0,935', case diameter 3.3cm.

Silver pocket watch (green roundel dial) - Winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently running. Dial in good condition. Silver case with some dents to case back and sides. Wood case good with only minor chips.

English hallmarked keywind in leather case - Generally good condition, winds smoothly and runs. Dial in good order. Case with typical scratches and minor wear.

.935 silver keywind - Does not run. Dial okay, Case okay with typical wear.

.935 silver keywind (fancy dial) - Winds but does not run. Dial has a hairline. Case with typical wear.

Keyless wind - Winds and runs. Dial is dirty but okay. Hour hand broken. Glass chipped to edge. Case is good with typical wear.
