A silver single cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement with verge escapement, the backplate detailed 'Willm Morrice, London 7188', the later adapted dial decorated with a rotating windmill and church landscape view, case diameter 5cm, with a curb link Albert watch chain, fitted with a silver T-bar and swivel, together with a silver cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch with unsigned fusee movement, London 1868, case diameter 5.4cm.

Condition Report

1193 - Windmill watch - Winds smoothly and is currently running, however please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Movement is good and clean. Dial with a few faint hairlines to edge between 1 and 2 o'clock. Later windmill subsidiary seconds is working. Case closes tightly. Typical surface scratches and wear. Good clear hallmarks. Replacement bow. The silver chain is a later example with typical surface scratches and wear.

The other watch winds but does not run. Hairline crack to dial. Silver case is okay but with wear to engine turned decoration.
