A Tudor Oysterdate stainless steel cased gentleman's wristwatch, Ref 7692, circa 1965, with signed jewelled 2403 caliber movement, the signed silvered dial with large rose motif at 12 o'clock and date aperture and detailed 'Shock-Resisting', the case back detailed 'Original Oyster case by Rolex Geneva', Rolex crown to winding button, numbered between the lugs '7962' and '484311', case diameter 3.4cm, on a black leather strap.
