A 20th century lacquered brass carriage alarm clock by L'Epée with eight day movement striking hours and half hours and repeating on a gong, the signed white enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals and subsidiary alarm dial, the glazed corniche case with swing handle and bracket feet, height 17.4cm, together with a smaller lacquered brass carriage timepiece, height 13.2cm.

1217. L'Epée clock in generally good clean condition. Case a little dusty but in good order with all glass panels in good condition, hinge door is good and handle good. Dial in good clean order. Movement winds smoothly and runs, striking mechanism and repeat in good working order, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Other timepiece in good order with only typical minor surface scratches and wear to case. Very minor chip to top edge of glass panel (not obviously noticeable). Movement winds and runs but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Dial in good order

Neither have their winding key but not difficult to source.
