LOT 1251

A George III mahogany longcase clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the 13-inch painted breakarch dial with rolling moon to arch above subsidiary seconds and date dials, inscribed 'Husband Hull' and cornered with fruit and flowers, the hood with pagoda top above a moulded arch pediment, glazed door and stop fluted Corinthian columns, the trunk with arched door and fluted corner columns, on a panelled base, height 233cm, with pendulum and two weights (lacking feet and finials).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1251. Hood in generally good order, typical scuffs and knocks, small section to left side split and re-glued, missing finials, some lifting to inlay.

Case in generally good order, typical nicks and knocks, missing feet, some typical splits to veneers, repaired section of veneer to side of lock, some chips and minor veneer losses.

Dial is worn and discoloured, obvious craquelure and missing date dial hand.

Movement is dirty and would require a service.

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
