Two Wemyss pottery porridge bowls, circa 1900, both painted with a black cockerel beneath inscription 'Save yer braith tae cuil yer parritch', beneath foliate moulded green rims, impressed and puce printed marks to bases, diameter 16cm. Provenance: from the collection of the late Graham and Rhiannon Berridge.

### Condition Report

Both bowls typically heavily crazed with light staining.

One has a minor nick to the underside rim edge approx 0.5cm long by 0.3cm wide.

The other bowl has a couple of pinhead sized glaze flakes to the green edge, only noticeable on closer inspection.
