A Stevens & Williams satin glass diamond air trap cameo vase, probably finished by Thomas Webb, late 19th century, the white pear shaped body overlaid with a rainbow of yellow, pink and green cameo, decorated with a fruiting tree surrounded by butterflies, height 21.5cm. Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

There is a minor nick to the main pink stem of the cameo decoration approximately halfway up the stem - this can be seen in image one on our website using the zoom function.

There are a few minimal surface blemishes to the white ground of the vase - a manufacturing issue - which are more easily felt than seen.

Otherwise the vase is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Some typical light surface scratches commensurate with age and use.
