A Bohemian ruby flashed and enamelled glass liqueur set, early 20th century, each piece with a ruby ground oval panel gilt with flowers against a ground of enamelled foliate scrollwork, comprising a conical decanter and stopper, height 28cm, and six shot glasses, together with a small group of other Bohemian glassware. Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.
