A large mixed group of Stourbridge threaded glassware, mostly late 19th century, including a pair of Stevens & Williams gold over amber dimpled beakers, height 10cm, a similar vase with diamond design, height 11.2cm, a tall pair of highball glasses with conical threaded bases, height 17.5cm, two shell shaped posy vases, a similar pair on oval mirrored bases and various finger bowls, rinsers and bowls (minor faults).
