A Villeroy & Boch Petite Fleur part service, comprising two graduated oval platters, three rectangular serving dishes, two oval serving dishes, two tureens and covers (one cover cracked), fifteen dinner plates, eight soup plates, fifteen dessert plates, twenty-two tea plates, ten dessert plates, one dessert bowl, five oval plates, four two-handed soup bowls and eight stands, a large circular bowl, sauce boat with integral stand, two cake plates, comport, teapot and cover, four teacups, eight coffee cups, twenty-one saucers, two jam pots and covers, milk jug, cream jug, sugar bowl, salt and pepper, six egg cups and four ramekins.

Condition Report

Dinner plates, soup plates and oval dishes - a few with signs of wear to the glazing, with scuffing, scratching and/or rubbing to the centres and around interior rims.

Both cake plates have some more noticeable deeper scratches to the surface, one more so than the other.

The rectangular dishes have some heavier signs of use, scratching and scuffing to interiors.

Other plates have very light overall scratching to their centres, typical of some use.

Overall the actual coloured decoration to the plates and other pieces is intact with minimal wear.

One tureen lid is cracked and badly chipped to the interior rim.

Teapot has a small hairline to the spout.

One dessert plate is star cracked.

Other pieces have no chips, cracks or restoration.
