A pair of Ridgway pottery sauce tureens, covers and ladles, early 19th century, relief moulded with flowers against a pale green ground beneath chocolate brown rims, the knobs and handles in the form of orange glazed roses, pattern No. 626, length 19cm. Provenance: from the collection of the late Graham and Rhiannon Berridge.

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

There is some general repainting/touching up to the chocolate brown rims which is covering up old glaze chipping. There are some more recent glaze chips to the rims which have not been retouched.

One lid has a hairline crack to the rim edge where the recess is for the ladle.

One ladle has a small area of amateur restoration to the bowl's rim.

Tiny chip to the orange rose of one base.

Some general crazing overall.
