Four Vienna porcelain circular bowls and covers, early 19th century, each painted with three floral panels to the base and cover, within gilt foliate scroll framing against a blue ground, the covers with lemon knobs, underglaze blue shield marks with impressed and painted numerals, diameter 14cm, together with two similar bowls and covers with scale ground decoration (faults and repairs).

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

1667. One blue bowl has a large chip to the rim with a crack emanating downwards towards the base (approx 8cm).

All of the lemon knobs have small chips to the applied foliage.

One blue ground bowl has been smashed into four pieces and glued back together again.

The green bowl has a large chip and a crack running all the way through it.

General age related wear throughout.
