A pair of Ridgway buff stoneware candlesticks, circa 1835, of foliate moulded form with acanthus leaf struts to the circular bases, unmarked, height 22cm, a matching smaller pair, height 12.5cm, five other pairs of Ridgway candlesticks, a pair of blue washed white stoneware candlesticks, probably Chetham & Woolley, and a pair of bluish-mauve pottery ram's head cornucopia with scattered gilt foliate decoration, height 15.5cm (some restoration). Provenance: from the collection of the late Graham and Rhiannon Berridge.

Condition Report

1433. One of the smaller buff candlesticks has a glued repair to foliate moulding.
One of the blue washed white candlesticks has numerous small chips around the footrim.
Restoration to one sconce on the blue foliate decorated candlesticks.
The white Ridgway floral candlesticks both have crazing all over.
Small hairline crack to underside of base of one of the blue cornucopia vases.
General age related wear throughout.
