Condition Report

1672. One stopper is cracked in half and repaired. Both lacking numerous floral encrustations and chips all over. The centrepiece also has small chips all over.

Floral encrusted vase has two damaged/re-glued feet.

Chariot group with re-glued horse's leg.

Various damage and small losses.
