A Berlin KPM porcelain plate, late 19th century, decorated with a central circular panel of a girl with a cornucopia basket on her back, underglaze blue and red printed factory marks to base, diameter 21cm, together with a mixed group of other Continental pottery and porcelain, including a pair of Staffordshire style sheep and a bisque figure of a female hunter, height 29cm. Provenance: from the collection of the late Graham and Rhiannon Berridge.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Staffordshire sheep - a few losses to bocage behind each sheep, each sheep with a chip to the ear

Seated musician - missing one or two flowers from chair

Brown glazed figure - restoration to hat rim

Female hunter - restored at the waist with overpainting, previously broken in two and repaired, restoration to gun.

Cream glazed figure group - cracked, one branch lacking, chips to other branches, one branch reglued, chips to hands

All other pieces in generally good condition, no chips, cracks or restoration
