A Royal Worcester fruit painted cabinet cup and saucer, circa 1925, painted by Moseley and W. Powell, diameter of saucer 11.2cm, and a similarly decorated tea plate, circa 1925, painted by H. Ayrton, diameter 18cm, puce printed marks to bases, together with two Royal Doulton models of dogs, HN1029 (hairline crack) and HN1099.

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

Cup - small hairline crack to the rim, with enamel/gilt loss in areas along the line of the crack, to exterior and interior

Saucer - some losses to the gilt decoration on the rim,

Plate - a couple of tiny enamel losses to the centre of the plate and to the interior rim edge

Crack to Doulton dog HN1029, other model of a dog in good condition.
