Three Chamberlains Worcester armorial dessert wares, circa 1814, comprising two plates, painted with the arms, supporters and crests of Sir John Doyle within a laurel wreath frame and gilt Greek key bordered rim, and a square dish with the crests of the full armorial within a matching laurel wreath and Greek key rim, red painted marks to bases, diameter of plates 23.8cm, length of dish 20.8cm (faults and repairs).

Condition Report

The Museum of Royal Worcester has details of the original order for this service in their archive of the factory records. They note it was an extremely large order originally recorded on July 30th, 1810 (order book 1808-1819, C7156 pp.79). The completed service was delivered on May 6th, 1814, at a cost of £283.66.
