### LOT 1765

A Worcester green ground inkwell with pounce pot base, circa 1820, of drum shape with relief white beaded borders, finely painted with a titled view of 'Worcester Bridge 1793' within a gilt rectangular frame, flanked by foliate moulded gilt pen holders, raised on four gilt paw feet and a circular foot, the pounce pot base with numerous pierced holes, painted marks to base, overall height 10.2cm.

Estimate: £300 - £400

### Condition Report

Pounce base with some crazing visible to the glaze, and minor unsprung chip to very edge of underside approx 0.4cm long.

Circular base of inkwell with 4 minor nicks and other little nibbles to its circumference. Otherwise the main body of the inkwell is in good condition overall, although I would suggest the green ground opposing the painted view has been re-touched. There are a couple of minor blemishes to the green ground around the upper central well aperture. Crazing is visible to the painted view and the top of the circular base primarily.

There is no removable inkwell.
