Two Royal Doulton 'Blue Children' series oval plaques, early 20th century, typically painted within gilt edge rims, green printed factory mark to one, length 35.5cm. Provenance: from the collection of the late Graham and Rhiannon Berridge.

Condition Report

Girl looking in basket - some long craze lines which are only visible in the right light on close inspection. To the reverse side edge there is a shaved down spot which is a manufacturing defect and is not visible from the front. Otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Girl behind woman - there is a small manufacturers glaze blemish to the upper surface on the very edge between 8 and 9 o'clock - this is only noticeable when held in the right light, please see image one on our website using the zoom function. The loops which support the hanging wire are noticeably glued into place, which suggests they may have been reattached. Otherwise the plaque is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
