### LOT 1762

Two Goebel Hummel pottery wall masks, each modelled as a woman's head with flowers in her hair, incised marks to reverse, length 18cm, together with a similar Czechoslovakian wall mask, printed marks to reverse, length 18cm.

### Condition Report

Mask with pink flowers in hair by Goebel - on her left side the top brown curl of her hair has been broken off and restored back with repainting to this curl and the two beneath it, with an associated hairline visible to the reverse of the mask and one to the front running vertically down the curls which has been disguised with restoration. On the other side of her head two of the flowers have some restoration to two of the petals. The tip of her nose has been retouched.

Mask with orange flowers by Goebel - two minuscule glaze nicks to edges of flower petals, some wear to tip of nose and tiny scratch to forehead.

Czech mask - minuscule blemish to her left cheek, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
