## **Condition Report**

Silver-mounted - there is a tiny burst air bubble like blemish (pinhead sized) to the very edge of the circular top, otherwise it is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. The removable silver sconce is a tiny bit misshapen and scratched. Its hallmarks match those on the actual candlestick.

Other candlestick - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
