A Gabriel Argy-Rousseau pâte-de-verre glass vase, 1920s, of ovoid shape with everted rim, relief decorated with a Greek key band against a ropetwist ground, in shades of muted yellow and brown, moulded signature mark amidst decoration and 'FRANCE' to base, height 24cm (drilled). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Condition Report

The vase has been drilled to accommodate a lamp fitting at some stage - please see the images on our website using the zoom function.

There are some small blemishes to the surface of the glass as a result of the manufacturing process, e.g., some burst air bubbles or inconsistencies to the footrim. Overall the vase is otherwise in good condition.
