### LOT 1414

An unusual pair of Ridgway porcelain spill vases and covers, circa 1820-30, of cylindrical form, painted with figural landscape views between gilt banding, the covers with seated cupid finials, iron red painted pattern No. 3/756 to bases, height 13cm, together with a matching pair of spill vases (lacking covers). Provenance: from the collection of the late Graham and Rhiannon Berridge.

### Condition Report

Two covers are missing.

The front edge of one of the covers (where Cupid's bow sits) has been broken off and professionally restored back with associated regilding.

One of the spill vases has a minor chip to the footrim, nothing untoward. Another of the vases has a few minor nicks to the top rim edge which have been re-gilt.

Otherwise each of the vases are in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

The gilding and enamels overall are good.
