Two Moser glass bowls and stands, late 19th century, each applied with relief acorns against a ground of brightly coloured enameled leaves, the first of blue tint with a square shaped bowl, the second of amber tint, gilt painted marks to bases, diameters of stands 15.3cm and 15.7cm.

Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Blue bowl and stand - both pieces in good condition overall, slight rubbing to gilding. No losses, damage or repair.

Amber bowl and stand - bowl in good condition overall with minuscule nick to top rim edge, more easily felt than seen, the stand is missing two of the applied acorns and has an area of polishing to the rim edge with overall rubbing to the gilding.
