LOT 1855

An 18th century style airtwist stem wine glass of Jacobite interest, the rounded funnel bowl engraved with a rose in bud and bloom with an oak leaf and sun flanking a thistle, on a multi airtwist spiral stem and conical foot, height 16cm, together with a Silesian stem champagne glass, height 15cm (air bubble fracture to rim). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

Jacobite interest glass - due to its small size (6.5cm diameter) I would suggest the foot has been reduced. There is a scratch to the bowl interior running horizontally from the stem to the oak leaf.

Champagne - the foot is 7.5cm diameter and I would again suggest it has been reduced. There is an internal air bubble fracture to the rim and a small spot of roughness to the bowl exterior.
