A crackle or ice glass jug and four matching goblets, circa 1900, with gilt rims and opaque twist stems and handle, height of jug 33.5cm, together with a large group of other crackle or ice glass, including a cranberry tinted jug with ice compartment, a similar clear decanter and stopper and a small tureen, cover and stand in the form of a stylized melon (minor faults). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

1914. Chip to gilt handle on shell form bowl and cover.

Chip to spout of lemonade jug.

Generally just minor age related wear to some gilding on the wine glasses.
