### LOT 1544

A Worcester sparrow beak jug, circa 1775, painted in coloured enamels with two Chinese figures, the rim interior with an underglaze blue geometric band, blue painted open crescent mark to base, height 9cm, together with two similar jugs, one painted with pink roses, the other with Compagnie de Indes flowers, a pair of New Hall coffee cups, painted with pattern No. 20, and a Lowestoft coffee cup (cracked and chipped).

### Condition Report

Figural jug - narrow 0.8cm long chip to middle section of spout, minor wear to enamels. Otherwise ok.

Roses jug - tiny nick to pointed end of spout, otherwise ok.

Other jug - small chip to exterior top rim edge by handle, otherwise ok.

New Hall cups - minor starcrack to base of one, otherwise ok.

Lowestoft cup - 2 vertical cracks to rim and small chip, extensive overall black pitting to glaze.
