A Worcester pierced circular basket, circa 1770-85, printed in blue with the Pine Cone Group beneath the flared sides pierced with interlocking rings, applied with flowerheads to the exterior intersections, hatched crescent mark to base, diameter 25cm, together with a similar smaller oval basket with latticework pierced sides and a pierced oval dish, decorated in the Gilliflower pattern, length 21cm (some faults and restoration). Provenance: the property of Michael Godfrey.

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

Circular basket - fundamentally in good condition overall with no restoration, two minor haircracks to pierced rim, a few of the applied flowerheads to the exterior have losses.

Long flat oval basket - handles restored back into position with associated restoration to the foliate handle terminals.

Other basket - pierced sides noticeably damaged and visibly restored.
