## **Condition Report**

Shepherd - missing right index finger and tip of left index finger, chips to brim of hat which is also missing part of its ribbon. Typical losses to applied relief flowers and foliage. Indistinct firing crack to right side of neck. Shepherdess - notable losses to applied flowers and foliage on base in comparison to the male figure. Glued repair to right wrist and right elbow, missing all fingers and thumbs on both hands, missing parts of ribbon at front of dress. Minor chip and crack to relief part of dress at back of figure.
