A cut glass jar and cover, 19th century, of ovoid shape with strawberry diamond panels, on a square foot, height 26.5cm, together with two pairs of spirit decanters and stoppers, two glass rinsers, a pair of oval bowls and other cut glassware (minor faults). Provenance: the property of Michael Godfrey.

Estimate: £50 - £70

Condition Report

1825. Brandy decanter has small chip to the top rim and three small chips to the footrim. Stopper on 'Brandy' and 'Gin' are later replacements.

Once of the pair of decanters has numerous chips to the stopper and three large chips to the top rim of the decanter, chip to footrim.

Numerous large chips to the single glass salt.

Overall age related wear and further very small chips in places.
